MAHLAP puts out new online periodical list

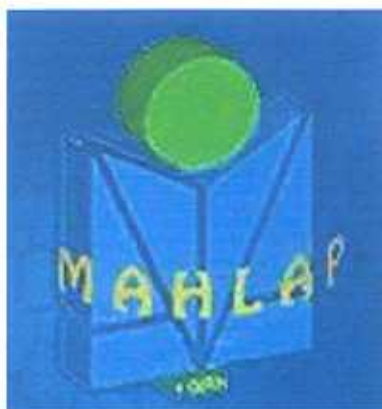
The Medical and Health Librarians Association of the Philippines (MAHLAP), in cooperation with Philippine Council for Health Research Development (PCHRD), reached a milestone in its service by having the National Union List of Medical and Health Periodicals going online.

The list serves as a search tool and ready reference for librarians, information providers and researchers on the availability of local and foreign medical and health periodicals in the different libraries and information centers all over the country. It is an important component of the networking transactions or resource sharing of the members of the organization.

During the launching ceremony held at the Multipurpose Hall of the Research compound last August 23, 2004, UNILAB Medical Education Development (UMED) director Dr. Edgardo Ortiz cited the various projects of the organization and underscored the UNILAB's participation and support to the organization's mission of making its services technologically up-to-date to the public.

MAHLAP officers and representatives of participating libraries of different schools, organizations and corporations attended the occasion and witnessed the signing of Memorandum of Agreement. Ms. Guillermina Panizales demonstrated on how to use the Online Union List of Serials, while Ms. Adaway Racal delivered her lecture on the history of Union list from its 1st and 2nd printed editions to its new format. Signing of the Memorandum of Agreement followed.

The MOA was signed on behalf of MAHLAP by Mrs. Filomena A. Juanillo who is the Organization's President, the
